AWS Subcommittee (Geoff)

- SRSP-503 & RSS-132, 800 MHz Cellular Band
 - No change since last meeting
 - Awaiting interference investigation results and determination whether further changes to standards are required
 - Review of docs completed other than any further changes that may arise from investigation of 800 MHz LTE/800 MHz Public Safety interference issue (ISED/Rogers/Peel Regional Police)



AWS Subcommittee (Geoff)

- RSS-192 Issue 4 & SRSP-520 Issue 1, Flexible Use Broadband in the Band 3450-3650 MHz
 - Work to introduce flexible use into band and incorporate 5G requirements
 - 4 of 5 meetings held; next meeting March 9th
- Key Issues outstanding:
 - Power levels, out of band emissions, coexistence with adjacent services, US border issues

Public Safety Subcommittee (Dave & Martin)

- Rogers – Peel Police Interference Issue
 - Investigation continuing with ISED and affected parties
 - ISED to advise regarding next steps



RSS-125 Working Group (Bob S.)

- 1.705 – 30 MHz Land Mobile and Fixed Equipment
- Changes in Issue 3:
 - Upper band limit lowered from 50 MHz to 30 MHz (removes overlap with RSS-119)
 - Broadens scope to other modulation types
 - Harmonized with FCC
- One Webex meeting held
- Revised draft distributed for any further comments
